321/19 APOLOGIES

No apologies for absence were received.

322/19 DECLARATION OF FINANCIAL INTEREST OR PERSONAL CONNECTION

Councillor Derek Hainge declared an interest in Agenda Item 5 Planning Appeal. Councillors Elin Walker Jones, Mair Rowlands and John Wynn Jones declared an interest in Planning Application C20/1089/11/LL.

323/19 URGENT BUSINESS

The City Director informed the Council that the Wales Audit Office report on Nantporth Stadium will be discussed at the City Council meeting on Monday 25 January 2021. The City Director and Acting Town Clerk also advised the Council that instructions on activating new Council email addresses will be sent shortly.

Cllr Les Day proposed that the Council consider purchasing a Zoom upgrade to help with virtual meetings. The City Director will review options and report back to Council.

Cllr Les Day proposed a temporary promotion to one of the Council employees, to reflect his additional responsibilities over the past few weeks. This was supported by the Council, and subject for approval at the City Council meeting on Monday 25 January 2021.

Cllr John Wynn Jones acknowledged the excellent work carried out by Council staff over the Christmas period, particularly the Awyr Las Christmas lights on the Pier. Cllr Jones thanked the staff for their hard work. This was supported by the Council.

Cllr Gwynant Roberts asked members of the Nantporth sub-committee to convene a brief update meeting following the Planning Committee.

324/19 PLANNING APPLICATIONS

RESOLVED: that the Gwynedd Planning Authority be advised that the City Council have the following observations to make on the applications listed below: -

C20/1030/11/LL Erection of 66 dwellings (to include 13 affordable dwellings), new access and associated works. Tir Ar Ffordd Llandygai, Bangor. **Objection. The Council acknowledges that developing dwellings on the land has been noted in the local development plan and supports the development in principle but has significant concerns regarding the entrance/exit to/from the A5 main road and the road safety implications and that the traffic assessment was insufficient. The Council also felt that there were insufficient details regarding the arrangements and provisions within the site and that these were not enough to be able to provide sufficient observations. The Council also asked whether it had received any pre-application information and if not, why not?**

C20/1040/11/DT Extensions and alterations. 3 Heol Penrhos. **No objection**

C20/1089/11/LL Erection of 6 dwellings (including an affordable dwelling) together with alterations to the existing access. Tir ar Lon Pobty, Bangor. **No objection**

C20/0617/11/LL Replace existing dwelling with a new dwelling and associated works. Hen Glawdd Ffordd Treborth, Treborth, Bangor. **Objection. Previous objection by the Council (Planning Committee 17 August 2020): the design of the building is not in keeping with other properties in the area in its current form. More information on the**

size of the development would have been appreciated, as it is currently somewhat vague. The Council does not oppose the principle of the development and would support it if the issues raised were addressed.

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C21/0002/11/LL Conversion of a 6 bedroom house to 2no two bedroom self-contained flats with internal and external alterations. 64 Ffordd Penchwintan. **No objection. However, the Council expresses some concerns regarding the over-development of the building.**

C21/0006/11/TC Application for an existing lawful use of the property as a house in multiple occupation. Brighton House Y Cilgant, Bangor. **The Council does not object to the application for an existing lawful full use of the property as a house in multiple occupation (HMO), if there is evidence to show that it has been used as a HMO. The Council is eager to see this kind of property being returned to use as properties suitable for local families.**

C20/1091/11/LL Extension of existing garage and excavate rock face at rear of site so as to extend the existing car park. Bangor Tyre Service, Bangor Tyre Service Ffordd Caernarfon. **No objection**
