56/16 URGENT BUSINESS

- a) Emergency Committee – **RESOLVED:** that a Committee comprising of the Mayor, Deputy Mayor, the Chairmen and Vice Chairmen of the Planning and Amenities and the Finance and General Purposes Committees and the Senior Member of the Council be appointed to consider any emergency items which may arise during the August recess and to give that Emergency Committee Powers to Act on behalf of the Council on any such matter.
- b) The Town Clerk announced that Councillor Christopher O’Neal had not attended a meeting of the Council or its Committees since 11th January 2016 and therefore his seat in the Marchog Ward should now be declared vacant under the six month non-attendance rule. **RESOLVED:** that the seat in the Marchog Ward be now declared vacant.
- c) Ombudsman Annual Report 2015/16 –The Town Clerk reported that a copy of the Report was available in the Office should any member wish to see it.

57/16 CITY CENTRE PARTNERSHIP

The Chairman introduced Mr Marc Roberts, from Cynlas Consultancy Company, who proceeded to give a presentation on the City Centre Partnership.

Mr Roberts gave the history to the project and updated on progress so far. He reported that a draft strategy and action plan would be presented to a meeting of the CCP Management Group on 19th July. He indicated that this would be available for circulation to Councillors once the Management Group had made initial comments upon it. The Chair thanked Mr Roberts for his interesting and informative presentation and looked forward to seeing the draft.

58/16 BANGOR BID

The Chairman introduced Mr Haydn Davies, Chair of Bangor BID who gave an updated report on the latest developments and projects that the BID was involved with. It was noted that the BID had undertaken to improve the streetscene and were anticipating expenditure on promoting the town centre including its fabric and information points. Members thanked Mr Davies for his presentation and he indicated that he would be willing to return to update Members on issues at a future meeting.

59/16 MENTER IAITH BANGOR

The Chairman introduced Mr Dylan Roberts who was the Welsh Language Manager for Menter Iaith which was based at Lon Poby. He indicated that this was a new initiative promoting the Welsh language through Gwynedd Council and it was to address the decline in the percentage of Welsh spoken within Bangor. The work of Menter Iaith would be to push new energy, opportunity more use and support of the language within the City as well as other initiatives. He invited Members to an Open Day on 15th October to formally launch the work of Menter Iaith Bangor.

Members thanked Mr Roberts for the presentation and his invitation. The Chair indicated that he looked forward to working with the organisation in the future

60/16 PLANNING APPLICATIONS

RESOLVED : that the Gwynedd Planning Authority be advised that the City Council have the following observations to make on the applications listed below:-

C16/0669/11/LL Change of use of 7 bedroom dwelling to a 7 bedroom house in multiple occupancy. 17 College Road, Bangor. **Objection – over-development of the site and there are too many HMO's already in this area.**

C16/0677/11/LL Erection of a 3 storey building to provide two shops and 10 living units for students and erection of a two storey building to the rear to provide 8 student living units. 146-152 High Street, Bangor. **Objection – over-development of the site and there are too many HMO's already in this area.**

C16/0685/11/LL Erection of new telecommunications equipment on top of the existing building in lieu of existing equipment. Bangor Telephone Exchange, Deiniol Road, Bangor. **No objection.**

C16/0694/11/CC Consent for works to several trees within Tree Preservation Order area. 20 Llys Adda, Bangor. **Objection – not necessary to destroy protected trees in this Preservation Order area just because it is the householder's preference. The Council strongly believes this work is unnecessary and would deprive the City of much valued woodland and greenery.**

C16/0781/11/LL Variation of condition 2 of permission APP/Q6810/A/16/314218 to amend internal layout of 2nd floor Providing 8, 1 bed units and 2, 4 bed units in lieu of 8, 1 bed units. Former Railway Institute, Euston Road, Bangor. **Objection – This represents an over-development of the site, there are too many hostels which are under-occupied and not enough development of accommodation for local people.**

C16/0784/11HY Erection of externally illuminated fascia sign. Robinson and Neal, Ltd., 43 High Street, Bangor. **No objection.**

C16/0798/11/CT Prior notification for the felling of trees within a conservation area. Adeilad Cerdd, Prifysgol Bangor, College Road, Bangor. **The City Council has deferred consideration of this as further information is required on proposals for the trees and the reason i.e. what development requires this work.**

Councillor Mrs J Marshall, as a member of the Gwynedd Council Planning Committee, took no part in the discussions on the above planning applications or voted on them apart from the applications within her own Ward.

61/16 PUBLIC CONVENIENCES

The Town Clerk reported that he was in receipt of correspondence from Gwynedd Council in respect of current and future use of their three public conveniences that were in operation within the City. The Council had asked whether Town and Community Councils were prepared to enter into partnership arrangements to ensure the toilets would be kept open for the year 2017/18.

This would involve a financial contribution from Bangor City Council to Gwynedd in the order of £10,000. The other request attached to the letter was whether the City Council would be prepared to enter into negotiations with regard to alternative arrangements. This might involve the City Council taking over the running of the conveniences either in part or in whole in the future. Members considered this matter carefully and were astonished at the costing figures provided by Gwynedd Council. Although they did not want to see any closures at this stage. Members equally wanted value for money and cleaner toilets which was not currently the case.

RESOLVED that the Town Clerk offer a reasonable figure however less than the £10,000 requested as the costs were considered too high. Should the offer not be received then the full £10,000 be offered for the next financial year with the proviso that the City Council be offered the chance to take on these facilities in the future subject to costings and future negotiations.

62/16 SALT BINS

The Town Clerk reported that he had been in correspondence with the senior manager at Gwynedd Council with regard to the filling of salt bins and replacing damaged bins should this arise. Gwynedd Council had confirmed that should the Council wish to take over the control and the filling of the bins any damage to the salt bins would have to be rectified by the City Council. However should the current ten salt bins within the Bangor area be maintained by Gwynedd Council the cost of refills would be £80 per bin subject to a cluster of three or £156 for a single bin. The Committee considered the issues and decided that in the best interest of the community it would be simpler to retain Gwynedd's provision for filling and replacing of any damaged bins.

RESOLVED that the status quo be maintained with the provision of salt bins.
