REPORT OF THE STAFFING PANEL 18 & 21 October 2019

The Town Clerk reported that the Staffing Panel had agreed a temporary offer of employment of two days per week with Mr Martin Hanks who was currently Clerk at Penmaenmawr Town Council for provision of a locum service to the City Council with effect from 4 November at a salary pro rata to the bottom of the advertised scale, these arrangements would be ongoing and flexible for both parties. Duties to be commensurate with the advertised job description but priority work would take precedent over more mundane matters. The departing Town Clerk would also provide one day cover per week up until mid December.

The staffing panel also agreed to undertake a review of all posts with the City Council's employment with a view to future requirements. It was recommended that a local HR Manager with local government knowledge be approached to undertake this review. It was noted that when Mr Hanks' council had been approached in this matter they were willing to assist with the City Council.

RESOLVED: that the actions of the Staffing Panel be endorsed and the suggested route be adopted as the way forward as soon as practicable.
