BANGOR GARTH PIER

RESTORATION PROJECT – PIERHEAD CLOSURE

Bangor City Council is in the process of repairing and renovating the superstructure of Garth Pier which is in need of urgent refurbishment.

Due to Health and Safety issues and an adverse structural engineering report the area known as the Pierhead will be closed to all with effect from 4 June 2018 as the structure is considered a danger to general public.

Unfortunately the Tea Room Pavilion will close as a result and no public access will be allowed to the Pier head until renovation works are complete. It is likely to remain closed for a period of nine months.

The City Council apologises for any inconvenience during this construction project but these works are deemed necessary to secure the stability and safety of the Pier for future generations to enjoy.
